

FLAG-ERA 2024 Project Seminar Meeting 17-18 September, Stockholm, Sweden

1 Arriving in Stockholm

Arriving in Stockholm by flight. If you come to Stockholm by plane, you will most likely land at Arlanda Airport. There are several ways to get into central Stockholm

- 1. **Arlanda Express (Circle 1)**. This is the fastest option with direct high-speed train right into the city in 18 minutes. A one-way ticket cost 320 SEK and a return ticket is 600 SEK.
- 2. **Flygbussarna, or Airport Coaches (Circle 2)**. This is the slower but cheaper option taking about 45 minutes. A one-way ticket cost 129 SEK and a return ticket is 209 SEK. There are discount for groups of 3 or 4 people. Flygbussarna is also the best option if you happen to land at the more central Bromma Airport.
- 3. **Commuter Train (Circle 3).** Follow signs to Arlanda C and buy a ticket at the circular counter. The ticket price is 171 SEK and it will take 39 minutes to reach Stockholm City station.
- 4. **Taxi.** The price will likely be above 650 SEK and take around 35-55 minutes depending on trafic conditions.

Arriving in Stockholm by train (Circle 3). There are night trains to Stockholm from either Hamburg or Berlin. These trains don't arrive until around 10 AM, hence you'd have to come a day early.

2 Meeting venue


The workshop will take place at the venues of "Piperska muren" at Scheelegatan 14 in the centre of Stockholm with a red marker in MAP 2 below (and the focus area in MAP 1 corresponds to the grey marker). The walking distance is not more than ten minutes from Stockholm central Station/ T Centralen. Unfortunately, the website is only in Swedish (https://www.piperskamuren.se/).

Piperska Muren is only for meetings, but there are many hotels within walking distance.

The name Piperska Muren comes from Count Carl Piper who bought the estate in 1694. "Muren" means "The wall" in Swedish and is relating to a red wall that was built around the magnificent baroque garden of the mansion. Piperska Muren is neighbour to the Stockholm Court house (Rådhuset), which has given its name to the closest subway station.
